Place Value In this unit on Maths, we will be looking at place value. We will begin by ordering, comparing and partitioning numbers up to 1,000,000. In the second half of this unit, we will round numbers to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000 within 1,000,000.		In writing we will study ' The Boy at the back of the Class ' by Onjali Q. Raúf. We will use this text to write our own diary entries and non-chronological reports. In Poetry, we will look at a range of poems by Benjamin Zephaniah such as ' Talkin Turkeys ' and ' The British ' and write and perform our own poems. In Master readers, we will study ' The Midnight Fox ' by Betsy Byars practising skills such as retrieval, predicting, retrieval, understanding vocabulary and discussing the author's intent and the effect on the reader.		
Addition and Subtraction This unit will start with us adding and subtracting numbers with more than four digits. We will then examine various strategies to verify whether our calculations are accurate.		History		
Multiplication and Division This unit will focus on the following: Multiples, common multiples, factors, common factors, prime numbers, square numbers and cube numbers.		Norman Invasion and Norman Britain In this unit of work we will find out how William of Normandy defeated Harold Saxon II in the Battle of Hastings, explore the Bayeux Tapestry as a source to find out about the Norman conquest and learn more about the Norman way of life during this period including how architecture and language changed in England and the Norman legacy.
